

Courses on Fresco at “Bottegas” Pieve School



Teacher's profile:

Professor Luciano Tittarelli born in Gualdo Tadino, got his degree in painting at the Academy of Fine Arts in Florence. He currently teaches Anatomy at the Academy of Fine Arts in Perugia. He started his career as a painter, sculptor and ceramist at the beginning of the 1970.

Since 1979 he lives in Perugia where he is one of the core founders of the movement Materiali/Immagini. In the same period he researches on new techniques of ceramics that lead him to initiate the artistic group “C come ceramica” (“C like Ceramics”).

His artistic language varies from conceptual installations to more traditional techniques and images.

A two days Fresco Workshop

Participants will enjoy a full immersion Fresco Class, being able to realize their fresco painting in only two days of apprenticeship. Classes will be held from 9.00 to 13.00 in the morning and 15.00 to 18.00 in the afternoon.

One week fresco Workshop

This course is intended to offer participants a wide experience on fresco techniques and history.

The workshop includes the following classes:

- *Fresco in art history*
- *Preparation of Fresco in ancient Rome, in the Middle Ages and during the Renaissance*
- *The “Sinopia”*
- *Preparation of materials and colors*
- *Realization of the fresco on a previously prepared board*
- *Realization of a landscape painting on fresco*
- *Realization of a human figure on fresco*
