Teacher's profile: Professor Luciano Tittarelli born in Gualdo Tadino, got his degree in painting at the Academy of Fine Arts in Florence. He actually teaches Anatomy at the Academy of Fine Arts in Perugia. He starts his career as a painter, sculptor and ceramist at the beginning of 1970. Since 1979 lives in Perugia where he is one of the core founders of the movement Materiali/Immagini. In the same period he researches on new techniques of ceramics that lead him to initiate the artistic group “C come Ceramica” (“C like Ceramics”).

His artistic language varies from conceptual installations to more traditional techniques and images.
