3. Align leadership character and behavior with identified core and universal values and organizational vision.

4. Understand change theory and begin to develop key facilitation skills in the change process (including technical and adaptive change) to move one's organization more effectively toward its established vision.
5. Create high performing team cultures that support both technical and adaptive change.
6. Resolve conflict through collaborative negotiations.
7. Develop effective communication, presentation and meeting strategies to advance organizational goals.
8. Develop a service ethic and action to sustain organizational effectiveness and broaden impact to the greater community.
